I CASTELL 01:

OUTGOING STUDENTS: the selection of these students is done one year in advance and in 2 rounds. Students are selected according to the average of their marks and the language skills. If these last are not sufficient LIUC organises language preparation courses to upgrade the students' language skills. If these requirements are not met students are not allowed to carry out the exchange. They are allocated a host institution after having checked with an academic tutor that there is a suitable study plan for them in host institution and that the student meets the language requirements indicated by the partner university. The International Office than supports the students prior and during their exchange.

INCOMING STUDENTS: the International Office (I.O.) at LIUC supports both the partner university and the incoming students from the nomination to the departure. They provide information on all aspects from the practical ones to the academic ones and act as interface with all the departments involved in the university.

The I.O. supports students as far as the accommodation on campus is concerned, while the accommodation off campus is supported by the Erasmus Student Network. The I.O. works very close with this association to welcome exchange students and to help them to integrate in the social and academic life of the University.

The I.O. organises an Orientation Week upon arrival of students in both semester to help them carrying out all the procedures to finalise their enrolment to the University and to give them all the necessary information for their stay.

Before the end of each semester the I.O. organises as well a Predeparture Meeting to inform students what they have to do before leaving and more information on the transcript of records and the documents they have to complete before leaving.

2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 5 weeks.
3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
4. Termination of the agreement can be done with a notice of at least one academic year. For example this means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 2015 will only take effect as of 1 September 2016. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
