About the program:

Seoul International Summer School (SISS) program at the University of Seoul was first established in 2000, and it has provided more than 100 international students with a great opportunity to learn about Korea, Asia, and the World. The international students are invited from UOS' partner universities and also non-partner universities. They can mingle with UOS Korean students in classes and in various cultural activities. By inviting professors from all around the world, the SISS program becomes more international and diverse with the professors' great dedication to the program. Requirements:

1. Arrival date: June 23, 2020 / Departure date: July 24, 2020
2. Teaching one of the undergraduate courses in English (listed below)

*Target group: sophomores or juniors from various nationalities including UOS
Korean students

3. Total number of teaching hours: 45 hours (3 hours/day for 15 days)

Selection Process

1. Seoul International Summer School Committee: February, 2020

2. Final Notification and Contract: March- April, 2020

Other information

1. There is no research expectation attached to the program
2. No teaching assistant provided
3. 1 class = 45 class (teaching) hours (including mid-term and final exams)
4. Classes start on June 25, 2020. However, all the SISS faculty members are required to attend faculty orientation which will be held on June 24, 2020. Classes end on July 23, 2020; grading should be completed within 1 week after the classes end and faculty members are required to remain in contact with their students for about 2 weeks after the program to reply to possible appeals on grades.
5. On-campus and off-campus housing with kitchen is available for your own expenses (around 1,000,000 Korean won per month depending on the room type available during the program). For the limitation of on-campus housing (International House) you shall be allocated to off-campus housing. Housing is offered by first-come, first-served basis.
6. Salary (9,000 USD) is paid by Korean won on the exchange rate of a designated day during the program. Each professor is required to have a bank account in Korea. If a professor does not have one, UOS will help open an account at the on-campus bank. Salary shall be paid only after the program starts.
7. SISS faculty members are welcome to join one-day extracurricular activities for free of charge.
