 **Other information**

1. There is no research expectation attached to the program
2. No teaching assistant provided
3. 1 class = 45 class (teaching) hours (including mid-term and final exams)
4. Classes start on June 29, 2017 However, all the SISS faculty members are required to attend faculty orientation which will be held on June 28, 2017. Classes end on July 26, 2017; grading should be completed within 1 week after the classes end and faculty members are required to remain in contact with their students for about 2 weeks after the program to reply to possible appeals on grades.
5. On-campus housing with or without kitchen available (around 1,000,000 Korean won per month depending on the room type available during the program at on-campus housing building)
6. Salary (9,000 USD) is paid by Korean won on the exchange rate of a designated day during the program. Each professor is required to have a bank account in Korea. If a professor does not have one, UOS will help open an account at the on-campus bank. Salary shall be paid only after the program starts.
7. Summer faculty members are welcomed to join all the extracurricular activities which are held in Seoul, free of charge.
